ClinicalConnect HIE is western Pennsylvania's health information exchange (HIE). ClinicalConnect HIE is a partnership of regional healthcare providers which improves the safety, quality, and efficiency of care for patients by securely connecting providers with patients' vital electronic medical records. Healthcare providers now have quick access to a patient's medical information, *such as allergies, medications, lab results, and past hospitalizations*, which is important to clinical decisions and patient care.

What is a Health Information Exchange?

A HIE is an information network that enables the electronic exchange of clinical information about a patient among a group of health care providers.
